By car

Steyning lies just north of the A27, close to the A24. Free car-parking is available at several of the town and village car parks.

By train

The nearest station is 5 miles away at Shoreham-by-Sea with trains to Brighton, London and Portsmouth. Please see www.nationalrail.co.uk
